

From the First World War

Private William Hepton

- Son of Elizabeth Hepton
- Died aged 27
- On 16th March 1919
- Buried in Great Addington Church Yard

Lance Corporal Arthur Abbott

- Killed in action 18th August 1916 in the first battle of the Somme
- One of 50,000 killed in 4 months of fighting
- No known grave
- Listed on the Thiepval Memorial

Private William Walter Tiney

- Killed in action on the 23rd July 1916 also in the first battle of the Somme
- Listed on the Thiepval Memorial
- There is a total of 72,000 soldiers from the first and second Somme battles who have no known grave

Private Harold Peck

- Died on 10th July 1917
- Recorded on the NIEUPOORT MEMORIAL,
Belgium
- No known grave
- One of 547 comrades who died fighting in the
area in July 1917

Also, Private Charles Loakes

- Born in Great Addington in 1882,
- But moved to Thrapston in 1915 where he is recorded on Thrapston's War Memorial
- 1 of 3 brothers
- Enlisted in Feb 1917
- Wounded in March 1918
- Died aged 36 during the Spanish Flu Pandemic on 4th December 1918 one month after the armistice
- Buried in VALENCIENNES COMMUNAL CEMETERY, France with 885 comrades

Second World War

Lance Corporal Stanley Hicks

- Son of James and Ivy Hicks; husband of Wilhelmina Hicks
- Died age 31 on 10th January 1944
- Buried in Great Addington Church Yard

Corporal John Joseph Wright

- Son of Henry and Rose Wright; husband of Anne Wright
- Died aged 21 on 24th May 1944 During the Anzio breakout in Italy
- Buried in the BEACH HEAD WAR CEMETERY, ANZIO with 2,316 comrades
